LEGALIZATION OF NORWEGIAN DOCUMENTS

1) COMMERCIAL CERTIFICATES: in order to legalize certificates such as: analysis, quality, patent or trade mark, origin, purity, health, animal health, free sale, apt for human consumption, free from radioactivity or patent of invention, etc..., they **must be issued by the Department of Agriculture, Health, Fish Directorate or the corresponding official Department in Norway.**

Phito sanitary certificates issued by official Norwegian departments **do not require consular legalization at this Embassy.**

Please be advised that Certificates issued by laboratories or private companies are not accepted.

2) COMMERCIAL DECLARATIONS such as: powers of attorney, letters of Representation, Company Registry or other similar documents: they must be duly authenticated by a Notarius Publicus, whose signature is registered at this Embassy.

3) PERSONAL DOCUMENTS such as: **Birth, Marriage or Death Certificates, Powers of Attorney, Study certificates**, etc... **do not require consular legalization** at this Embassy as long as they are authenticated by the "Fylkesmannen" with the "Apostille" stamp.

NOTE:

Please, do not make any deposit until we check your documents and indicate the corresponding consular fee and the account number.

When sending documents by mail, please arrange their pick up with a courier company or include a prepaid return envelope in order to guarantee their safe return.
