

## GENERAL INFORMATION

CITIZENS FROM THE FOLLOWING COUNTRIES TRAVELLING AS TOURISTS TO VENEZUELA BY COMMERCIAL VESSEL OR AIRPLANE DO NOT NEED A TOURIST VISA TO ENTER THE COUNTRY. ALL THEY NEED IS A VALID PASSPORT FOR A MINIMUM OF SIX MONTHS AND A TOURIST CARD TO BE PROVIDED BY THE TRANSPORTING COMPANY:

ANDORRA, ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA, ARGENTINA, AUSTRALIA, AUSTRIA, BARBADOS, BELGIUM, BELIZE, BRAZIL, BULGARY, CANADA, CHILE, CZECH REPUBLIC, COSTA RICA, DENMARK, DOMINIQUE, DUTCH ANTILLES, GERMANY, GREECE, GRENADA, GUATEMALA, FINLAND, FRANCE, HONG KONG, HUNGARY, IRELAND, ITALY, ICELAND, JAMAICA, JAPAN, LIECHTENSTEIN, LITHUANIA, LUXEMBOURG, MALASYA, MEXICO, MONACO, NORWAY, NEW ZEALAND, NETHERLAND, PARAGUAY, PANAMA, POLAND, PORTUGAL, SPAIN, RUMANIA, SAINT KITTS AND NEVIS, SAINT LUCIA, SAINT MARINO, SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRANADINES, SOUTH AFRICA, SWEDEN, SWITZERLAND, TAIWAN TERRITORY, TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO, UNITED KINGDOM, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, AND URUGUAY.

CITIZENS FROM OTHER COUNTRIES MUST APPLY FOR A TOURIST VISA.

IF TRAVELLING BY PRIVATE BOAT / AIRPLANE OR ENTERING THE COUNTRY BY LAND, ALL NATIONALS MUST APPLY FOR A TOURIST VISA.

## **TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN**

This is to certify that Norwegian citizens travelling to Venezuela as tourists do not need to be provided with a visa to enter the country and stay in Venezuelan territory for up to three months.

The only formality that they must fulfil is to bear a Norwegian passport valid for a minimum of six months and a tourist card to be provided by the transporting company.
